1 Introduction

We are very pleased to announce the latest release of Votiro's Secure File Gateway, version 9.6. The focus on this version has been on extending integration with other platforms and technologies, improving performance and expanding existing capabilities.

In this release we introduce an additional menu item: Cloud Connector, with connectors for AWS S3 and Menlo Security. We also have an exciting connector in Beta for Chrome, to be released within the month.

The Dashboard now allows SAML configuration settings to be added. This enables single sign-on (SSO) technology to authenticate a user logging into Secure File Gateway when already signed-in to their organization's systems.

We have improved security and resilience aspects through OVF hardening and high availability. The reporting mechanism has been adjusted resulting in improved report generation times. This release also supports the processing of Excel95 file formats.

As always, we fixed several bugs and carried out general product maintenance to provide a more stable environment with an ever-increasing throughput of files for processing.



2 New Features

The following new features and improvements are added to this version of Votiro's Secure File Gateway.

2.1 Cloud Connector - AWS S3



This release introduces a new dashboard menu for AWS S3 cloud connectors. AWS S3 storage buckets are setup to use Amazon's Simple Queue Service (SQS), a web service for storing messages in transit, in this scenario with Votiro's VA. AWS S3 bucketsare used to exchange files with Votiro's VA for processing by our Secure File Gateway's Positive Selection® Engine without impacting your network.

2.2 Cloud Connector - Menlo Security



This release introduces a new dashboard menu for Menlo Security connectors. it is for customers that have deployed enterprise Menlo with Browser Isolation and Secure File Gateway for Web Downloads.

Both should be deployed on-premises or in your corporate clouds.

2.3 Supporting Processing of Larger Files




Based on feedback from customers the processing capability for specific large files has been increased as follows:

- 2GB archives
- 2GB video
- 2GB CSV

2.4 Support for Excel95 File Format




In this release we have further added to the legacy excel formats detected in our Positive Selection® process.

It transpired that several customers were still actively using Excel95 files, we listened, and now include these files in our expanding suite of file formats processed.



2.5 Improved Security & Resilience



Installation of the virtual appliance now includes OVF hardening, further improving security.

This release also provides improvements supporting high availability, to a maximum limit of 2 nodes and 4 nodes.

2.6 Improved Report Generation



In this release we adjusted the reporting mechanism to imporive report generation times. We have measured a significant decrease in the average time it takes to produce reports.

2.7 SAML Configuration Settings



Configuring SAML settings from the Dashboard allows users to access Secure File Gateway using single sign-on (SSO) authentication technology.
