1 Introduction

We are very pleased to announce the latest release of our Votiro Secure File Gateway solution, version 9.3.

In this release we introduce a version containing many critical improvements to the security, robustness and integration of the Secure File Gateway into large organizations. The strategy being implemented enables Votiro's Secure File Gateway to integrate with your organization's existing infrastructure, utilizing and leveraging your existing assets. This includes using an external storage server, whilst retaining the capacity within the application to continue processing should there be a failure with the connection. In addition to this, an external load balancer may be leveraged too.

Improvements to the way Secure File Gateway handles emails has resulted in a minimum of 17,000 emails being processed per hour. Another new feature in this release is an official upgrade path for your Secure File Gateway installation, enabling a smooth transition to the latest features and improved resilience.

2 New Features

The following new features and improvements are added to this version of the Votiro virtual appliance.

2.1 Official Upgrade Procedure

This release provides an official upgrade procedure allowing you to upgrade your current Secure File Gateway installation to this latest version. For assistance with this procedure please contact the Votiro Support team who will be happy to provide the upgrade script and guide you through the process.

2.2 Email Handling Improvement

This release sees a step-change in the way Votiro's Positive Selection Engine handles emails. This includes the methodology used for positive selection processing and a change to the third-party libraries embedded in Secure File Gateway.

The results are a significant increase in the number of emails passing through the Positive Selection Engine intact.

2.3 Support of up to 17,000 Emails per hour

The internal improvements to the processing capabilities of the Positive Selection Engine has enabled Votiro to become a Secure File Gateway tool of choice for organizations with high email traffic flow.

We are seeing well in excess of 17,000 emails processed by the Positive Selection Engine in an hour.

2.4 External Disk Storage Support

This release provides a more robust method of using an external storage server with your Votiro Virtual Machine. Votiro's Secure File Gateway can be configured to communicate with your storage server, using a mount from the external storage to the Virtual Machine.

This is transparent when using Votiro's Positive Selection Engine, which is still available for processing should there be an external storage server link fail.

3 Deprecated Features

3.1 Removal of Feature Adding an Email Footer

In this release we remove the feature allowing email footers for HTML-based emails and/or text-based email to be added. The feature action had previously been available in the Management Dashboard's **Defining Policy by File Type** page.

3.2 Removal of Policy by Active Directory Setting

In this release we remove the setting allowing positive selection policies to be set per Active Directory group. Policies will be applied to all users uniformly.
